Health Insurance / Medical Services

Foreign tourists do not pay for medical services if a Health Care Convention was signed between Croatia and the country of origin.

Opening Hours

Banks and post offices are normally open from 8 a.m. to 7 or 8 p.m. Non-Governmental offices work from 8:00 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Most grocery stores and department stores are open non-stop, from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 or 8 p.m.

A tax refund is available to foreign citizens for purchased goods exceeding 500 Kuna, providing that the form entitled "Porezni ek" (Tax Cheque) is stamped by a customs officer upon leaving the country.
